You have to set up an account to use this program. I can't wait to see how many AOS shirts I see at the next Member's meeting in Chicago.

The Vista Print program offers more merchandise and even allows the affiliates to print shirts with their own logo, it just has to be uploaded in specific file formats (.png, .eps, .svg file formats). Already loaded and available are various AOS tablecloth, table runner, and flag options. I always wondered where the table covers and flags that I would see at various shows around the country came from. I found out that many years ago, a generous donor gave funds to create the table covers and flags and sent them to each judging center. The JC was tasked with storing them and providing them to each show in their judging region. Even though my JC is very small, I don't remember ever seeing the table covers or flags flown at any of our societies shows and they have long since disappeared. If that is the case for your society, this is an opportunity to get your own table covers or flags.

One of the best places to recruit new members for your societies is at shows. What better way to bring attention to your society table than to show off your AOS membership with flashy table covers and flags? The more we both grow, the more we can support each other.

LES ORCHIDOPHILES DE MONTRÉAL SOCIETY SUGGESTION

At our orchid society, Les Orchidophiles de Montréal, we were noticing a decline in participation to the monthly "orchid show and tell" table.

To try and boost participation, we implemented a contest called "Les pouces les plus verts" (The Greenest Thumbs). This is a point system whereby orchid exhibitors receiving ribbons at the monthly show and tell table accumulate points (1st=5 points; 2nd= 3 points; 3rd=1 point). Points accumulate from March to February the following year and are tracked in our monthly journal for everyone to see. At the end of February, the number of points per exhibitor is converted in tickets for a draw of 3 prizes in cash for the winners to buy more orchids during our orchid show, Orchidexpo, the following month.

We have been doing this for 3 years now, and the participation has increased significantly since!

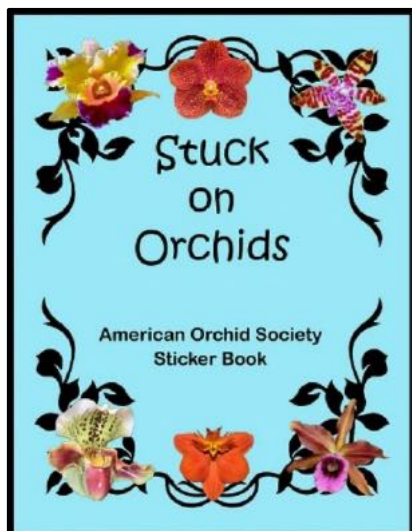

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NEW AOS STICKER/ACTIVITY BOOK RELEASED

Most of you are familiar with the Education Committee's children's sticker book *Stuck on Orchids*. This book was first published in 2022 and has been very popular with children at orchid shows and schools. This book comes with a Teacher's Guide for any society that would like to host a more formalized children's education program. The sticker book is 16 black and white pages printed on coloring book paper. It has 51 full-color stickers on pages inserted in the back. We chose seven of the more common orchid genera to include in this book: Phalaenopsis, Cattleya, Cymbidium, Oncidium, Vanda, and Dendrobium.

I'd like to introduce our second sticker and activity book *Orchid Adventurers* which was created this year. The new book mimics the time of the orchid hunters of the late 1800s and follows orchid adventurers Max and Aria. It has new genera to explore, different stickers, and activity pages. Plans are to also create a Teacher's Guide for this book in the new future.

I'm very excited to announce that both books are now are in the process of being printed. It does take time as the stickers are printed at one business and then sent to the printer of the books to be inserted and put into plastic sleeves. Once per year, affiliated societies can request a box of these sticker books.



The books are free and are shipped with about 50 books in a medium priority shipping box. For this fall's shipments, we will be including copies of both books. The society just needs to pay \$22.80 for shipping. **If you are interested in this, contact Lydia at the AOS Office at theaos@aos.org.** Lydia can help you make arrangements for payments. If your society would like to purchase additional copies of the sticker books, that can be arranged as well for a small charge per additional book.
